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This week was a great week, we are now in the Bronx for clinical. My greatest challenge this week was once again getting computer access and working with the nurse. I did have a small issue with communicating with the patient. It was my first time working with a patient who suffered a gunshot wound. I had to ask what brought him into the hospital, but he didn't want to talk about it, but the professor came in and the patient told her what really happened. I had to learn the correct way you ask a patient to tell you what happened rather than beating around the bush. For this patient I will say my greatest accomplishment was getting my vitals and other assessments done on him early. My technical skills were very limited this week, I did not do anything outside of the norm. Interpersonal skills with the patient definitely needed some improvement in the beginning but as the day progressed it got better. With the staff it was a bit rocky, the nurse was a float worker so she wasn't familiar with the floor or the computer system. With my other classmates' interpersonal skills were great. We all helped each other with making the beds and changing patients' sheets and gowns that weighed a bit more. An area of improvement will be having more knowledge, there's some things that are learned through experience only. The scripture for this week is Isaiah 41:4 "do not be afraid... do not fear, for I myself will help you." declares the Lord, your redeemer, the holy one of Israel."
