- **Statement of Need**

- Awareness and thorough understanding of the vaccine purpose, risks, benefits, schedule, surveillance, and other relevant information will help to reduce the risk of spreading/acquiring disease or illness and improve immunity by promoting health protection, disease prevention, and in overall, enhance the well-being of each individual and the community they reside in.

- **Goal**

- The goal of this information session is to educate adults about vaccination benefits, risks, benefits, dosages, and schedule.

- **Objectives**

- At the end of this information session, the adult will be able to verbalize benefits of vaccinations, explain when they should receive a vaccination and how many times they will receive a vaccination.

- **Evaluation**

- The effectiveness of this education will be evaluated by the adults' answers to questions at the end of this session. The adult will be given a brief survey with questions and answers to fill out. Adults must receive a score of 80% or better to have understood the education. If an adult does not receive a score or 80% or better, then reinforcement of education will be needed.
