THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- The minimum standard for Federal and Institutional Financial Aid is a GPA of 3.0 each semester and register for a minimum of 6 credits.
- Financial Aid will disburse after Add/Drop period January 27th. Once tuition and financial aid is on your Nyack account we will make a stipend check and mail to you.
- In-School Deferment forms are completed by the Office of the Registrar after the Add/Drop period.
- Last day to withdraw from class means you will get a W/D instead of an F but still incur full liability for the course.
- Fafsa is only completed once every year for the Academic Year (Fall, Spring & Summer).
