After graduation on May ....., 2021, I look forward to the Live Kaplan Review from May ... through the ....., along with an independent seventy-five Kaplan comprehensive questions followed by review of rationales each day that will point out my strengths and weak areas. Thereafter, I intend on following the above schedule. I will begin by purchasing a NCLEX study plan from NURSING.com (NRSNG). With this I will have access to computerized adaptive tests that simulates that of the NCLEX. I will begin my day by attending the nearby library each day starting at 9.00 AM to 2:30 PM Monday through Friday. I have set aside Saturdays for rest and family time, Sundays are set aside for worship. I am sure that I will find myself very bored occasionally on a weekend and end up doing some questions. For the first three days, I will commence my study plan with Fundamentals of nursing; each day will consist of 100 questions followed by a review of the rationales. The next two days of the second week will be focused on maternity nursing. I will begin week three with pediatric nursing on Monday and Tuesday, followed by mental health nursing on Wednesday and Thursday, and culminate with nursing management on Friday. On the fourth and fifth weeks, I anticipate testing my knowledge in all areas of adult health alterations nursing. The plan is to attempt one hundred questions on each system, followed by a review of rationales. For the sixth week, I plan on reviewing common medications, EKG charts, and Laboratory values; each day will be followed by a comprehensive review of seventy-five questions. Finally, on the last day of my study plan, I will be doing a comprehensive review test consisting of two hundred sixty-five questions with a review of rationales. The total number of questions listed in the above plan amounts to 3,105, but might be increased depending on the allotted test date. Although I am not yet sure of the available dates for the NCLEX, I hope to sit the examination on .....
