Biblically Based Discipline Plan

Classroom Standards : RESPECT, COMPASSION, OPEN MINDEDNESS

Teachers' Expectations of:

Parents:

- Do not deny/ avoid responsibility
- Communicate with me your expectations and what you think your child needs
- Respect my authority as the student's teacher
- Be an active participant in your child's education
- Be open to having a relationship with me
- Work alongside me and trust that I have your child's interest at heart

Students

- Communicate with me how I can best help you learn
- Have for respect for me, your peers, and yourself
- Be considerate of your own classroom behavior
- Take initiative in helping around the classroom and helping other peers
- No negative comments towards yourself or others
- Be responsible for cleaning up after yourself
- Ask for help when needed

If you do your work:

Rewards

- 1) Your voice will be heard
- 2) Your ideas will be shared
- 3) Your uniqueness will be celebrated
- 4) Your peers and I will support you to be successful!

If you don't do your work:

Consequences:

- 1) I will talk to you
- 2) I will listen to you
- 3) We will work together to figure out a plan to help get your work done
- 4) Your peers and I will support you to be successful!

If you follow the classroom standards:

Rewards:

- 1) You will be appreciated
- 2) You will be inspired
- 3) You will make friends
- 4) You will learn and grow!

If you don't follow the classroom standards:

Consequences:

- 1) I will sit with you
- 2) I will listen to you
- 3) We will talk to your parents and work together to see how we help you be the best you can be!
