Write a comparative essay based on one of the topics below. Your essay should be at least 600 words and it should follow MLA formatting rules. This essay should be based on your personal perspective, so you are not required to consult sources. However, if you do, you must follow MLA citation rules correctly (in-text citations and works cited). Choose one of the following topics:

1. Compare a book to its movie version. How are the two similar and different? Are the characters and the plot the same? Do you like the movie or the book better? Explain your answer.
2. Compare the situation in a country/city before and after a major historical event.
3. If you moved to the United States from another country, discuss the major ways in which your life changed when you immigrated to the US.
4. Show the similarities and differences in the ways that two cultures celebrate an important event, such as a birthday, wedding, or a holiday.
5. Compare a job you liked with one you did not like and give reasons for your views.
6. Compare two different approaches you have used to study, such as studying in a group and studying on your own using notes or other aids. Explain whether you prefer one approach over the other.
