Time Frame

- 1) **10 Minutes for Prosecution to make case (Includes Witnesses)**
 - Prosecution must state their position at the beginning of the trial
- 2) **10 Minutes for Defense to make case (Include witnesses)**
 - Defense must state their position at the beginning of their portion of the trial
- 3) **5 Minutes for Prosecution to cross examine Defense Witnesses**
- 4) **5 Minutes for Defense to cross examine Prosecution Witnesses**
- 5) **2 Minute for Defense Final Statement to Jury**
- 6) **2 Minutes for Prosecution Final Statement**
- 7) **5 Minutes for Jury Deliberation**
- 8) **Foreman to announce verdict – they must come to one the following verdicts:**

“After deliberation,

 - a) “We the people unanimously find the evidence for the Prosecution to be the most compelling”
 - b) “We the people unanimously find the evidence for the Defense to be the most compelling”
 - c) We the people were unable to render a unanimous decision for neither the Prosecution, or the Defense
