PowerPoint Presentation Tips and Guidelines

1. The individual slides will basically follow the items from your tasks.
2. **Introduction:** Slides 1-5 are all part of the Introduction of your presentation.
3. **Body:** Slides 6 on are all part of the Body of your presentation.
4. **Conclusions:** The last few slides are the concluding points of your presentation.
5. **Final slide:** This slide lists your sources.
6. Review the yellow highlighted sections of your task list. This is where I guided you what to put in your slides.
7. Be familiar with your research.
8. Know the main ideas you want to be sure to present.
9. Each slide in the body section should have a main idea.
10. Highlight key words.
11. Do not include too much information on each slide.
12. Do not exclusively read through your entire research paper.
13. Plan to take about 25-30 minutes plus 10-15 minutes for questions.
14. Feel free to include different fonts, colors, pictures, special effects, and/or video clips.
15. Don't rush.
16. Remember: **YOU ARE THE EXPERT!**
17. Be yourself. Have fun!

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| Slide 1: 1 minute | Research Topic: this answers what you chose too focus your research Student Name Course Name |
| Slide 2: 1 minute | Your 2 Disciplines plus your 2 Mentors This answers who assisted you in your research. If your mentors are present, introduce them. |
| Slide 3: 2-4 minutes | Introduction to your presentation: Include your proposal. This answers the following questions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Why you chose this topic. 2) Why this topic is important. 3) Why this topic was important to you. 4) Set the context of your research: What is the background to the information presented? |
| Slide 4: 2-4 minutes | This slide presents the research questions you undertook. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) List your research questions. 2) List the significance of each question. |
| Slide 5: 2-3 minutes | This slide includes your outline: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) List your outline sections: Introduction, Body, Conclusion 2) Let the listeners know where you are going |
| Slides 6...on 10-15 minutes | You choose how many slides you have from this point on. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Look through the body of your research. 2) Synthesize the main points from each page of your research. 3) Include the research discovered. (Include authors.) 4) Use stories to illustrate and make the presentation interesting. |
| Concluding Slide(s) 2-5 minutes | Present your Conclusion: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Conclusions can include your answers to the research questions. 2) Conclusions should also include any questions you are left with. |
