You may wish to learn the vocabulary on page 67 first because many of the adjectives are used in the following exercises.

1. Circle each of the adjectives below, and then complete the table stating the adjective's use (predicative /attributive),<sup>1</sup> gender, and number

<sup>2</sup> Don't forget to watch out for proper nouns, i.e. names of people and places. It is important that you remember to identify whether the noun/adjective is definite. If there is an imbalance (one definite and the other indefinite) then you need to translate the clause as predicative.

There are no strong people in Israel.
טוב הכסף מזהב
Silver is better than gold.
וילך אברהם אל כנען מארץ רחוקה

ויעש יהושע ברית עם עם רע
Joshua made a covenant with an evil people.
ויאמר דוד אל-האיש הישר מי אתה
David said to the upright man, "who are you?"
יש נשים יפות בארץ
There are beautiful women in the land.
ויאמר אלהים לנשים הגדולות
God said to the great women
כי אתה עם קדוש ליהוה
For you are a holy people for the Lord
ויתנו שלמה ודוד למלך כסף רב
Solomon and David gave a lot of money to the king.
