

## Guided Reflection Questions for Medical Case 2: Jennifer Hoffman

### Opening Questions

How did the scenario make you feel?

The scenario gave me a better understanding of what it takes to care for Asthma patients

### Scenario Analysis Questions\*

**PCC** What assessment findings would indicate that the patient's condition is worsening?

**\*Oxygen saturation > 92%**

**\*Skin color change**

**PCC** When a patient develops a rapid onset of shortness of breath, what are the nurse's immediate priorities?

**\*Keeping the airway unobstructed**

**\*Maintain SPO2 as high as possible**

**\*Making sure patient is calm**

**\*Patient in a high fowler's sitting position.**

**PCC/I** Review Jennifer Hoffman's laboratory results. Identify which results are abnormal and discuss how this relates to her clinical presentation and the disease process.

**\*Low O2 saturation level, lower than 92% indicate deficit in perfusion due to narrowing of airway.**

### Concluding Questions

What communication techniques are important for an extremely anxious patient who is having difficulty breathing?

**\*Encouraging the patient to take a deep breath and reassuring the patient I am here to care until there is improvement**

What patient teaching priorities would be important for the patient who has experienced an acute exacerbation of asthma?

**\*Keeping the patient calm**

What discharge instructions regarding home medications would you provide the patient related to medications to use to alleviate symptoms of an acute asthma attack?

**\*Avoid trigger and monitor peak flow.**

What resources would you recommend for the patient experiencing asthma? **I recommend patient to get more information on the internet on how to get support for asthma.**

What is the importance of the asthma action plan in managing the care of a patient with asthma? **It helps to prevent flare-ups and emergency and it is the best way to keep asthma under control.**

What would you do differently if you were to repeat this scenario? How would your patient care change? **Repeating the scenario will improve my solving problem experiences.**
