

Well, the Bible provides no record of Jesus addressing Joseph in any way, and the only recorded uses of "father" by Jesus are in reference to God the father.

Luck 2:39--52 relates Scripture's only record of an event in Jesus's life occurring between his infancy and adulthood. His family travels to Jerusalem for a feast. When returning, Mary and Joseph lose track of Jesus, assuming He is with others in their large group. They find him in the temple, he refers to the temple as his "father's house".

Jesus is not asking why Mary and Joseph were looking for him, in general, he is suggesting that the temple is the only place they should have expected him to be. Discussion 1
