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Luke 17:1-10:

Subject: The disciples.

Complement: Things will cause them to stumble.

Main idea: Be careful.

Isaiah 7: 1-17:

Subject: Ahaz the King of Judah.

Complement: King Ahaz and Judah was afraid when Syria joined forces with Israel.

Main idea: Don't be afraid. The Lord will give a sign of Immanuel.

1 Peter 5: 1-4:

Subject: The Elders.

Complement: Watch over others who are under them.

Main idea: be honest. Do not take advantage of others.

Psalms 131:

Matthew 18: 15-20:

Daniel 4:

Main idea: The Lord God is Sovereign over all Kingdoms and nations.

Luke 8: 1-18:

Subject: Jesus and his disciples.

Complement: Always pray.

Main idea: Trust God.

1 Thessalonians 1: 2-10:

Subject: The Thessalonians

Complement: The gospel came with word and power.

Main idea: Become imitators of God.

Matthew 18:21-35:

Subject: Peter
