According to Karger & Stoesz Policy frameworks provides decision makers with information to serve the public. Understanding the functions and the implication of policy focuses on problems and addressing issues for the public by solving social problems through policy frameworks. This is a systematic model for examining a particular social welfare policy. Policy frameworks can assess key social welfare values and analysts can also employ social justice and equity within policy. (Karger & Stoesz – PG 30)

The eight key elements of policy Frameworks

- Policy frameworks attempt to systematically analyze a social policy or program
- Policy frameworks reflect the understanding that social policy is context sensitive and that there are competing priorities in all policy options.
- Policy frameworks employ rational methods of inquiry and analysis. The data used in policy analysis must be derived from objective scientific inquiry and must come from legitimate sources and should be interpreted as analyzed as much as possible.
- Analytic method is explicit and all succeeding policy analyses much be approximate in the same conclusion.

- Policy analysis is based on the commitment to derive the largest possible social cost. A good social policy is one that benefits at least one person at the same time injuring someone.
- Policy frameworks should attempt to consider the unintended implications of a particular program structure.
- Policy analysis should consider alternative social policies or alternative uses of potential impact of a policy on other social policies and social problems allocated for future resources for a given policy.
- Policy frameworks must review the potential impact of policy on social issues and social problems in society.

The purpose of policy framework is to provide analysts to perform and examine policy to study the reasons why a bill or policy fail in in the U.S and some benefit why the majority suffer. The choice of a policy framework must fit the require project and provide resources to analyze a project for effectiveness. (Karger & Stoesz – PG 29)

A government operating framework will have a structure of the organization structure to control and support the roles established to design the governance framework.

The Oversight responsibilities are committees, authorities and responsibilities, management and accountability and rights. Talents and culture should be part of the framework which includes business and operating principles, core beliefs, leadership development and management incentives.

The infrastructure, policies and procedures, communication, and technology to establish design, measure, and metric alarm with governance requirements for social problems and social issues. Policy needs to be analyzed and examine to be put in place to benefit the public to

be effective for all people. This is the opposite of the US welfare system because there are so many thresholds in the system that some children are left in poverty and discriminated.
