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France had an absolutism approach, vs. England had a very constitutionalism approach which was very different from ruling their nation. What if Louis's invasion had been successful? An individual would've controlled England, and a parliamentary government would've been out of the picture for England. John Locke was an advocate for constitutionalism government and believed that a ruler on a constitution was the best fit for the citizens. So, John Locke wouldn't have mattered if France had invaded England. North America would've come under French rule.
