I was told not to worry, there is no wrong or right in verbatim, all I had to do is the enter what happen when I enter to the patient room until I leave the room. I think I got the hang of it as I kept on practicing. After visiting with the patients that chaplain allow me to chart my assessment under his name with his supervision.
