Despite the fact that the Enlightenment cut across many fields, 3 central concepts defined it. The philosophies who played a key role in the 18th century French enlightenment are examples of people who exhibit these traits in their writing.

Individualism the viewpoint that all men regardless of their size should be granted an equal number of fundamental rights in order to give them best chance to succeed.

Reason Promoting the scientific method as a replacement for religions dogmas superstition and the churches trannys. The conviction that progress will be facilitated by a deeper comprehension of the world

Skepticism The recognition that it may be very difficult for humans to fully comprehend the world in which they live; as a result, critical thinking is essential for knowledge to advance and grow

To avoid another era of intolerable religious conflict enlightenment thinkers sought to limit the political influence of organized religion. Separating church and state was encouraged during the radical enlightenment.

The status quo was vigorously contested during the Enlightenment, and reason started to take the place of conventional superstition ideals. As a result, knowledge and concepts in the fields of art, literature, an philosophy,

politics, and science were all altered, initially by adapting texts from classical Greek and Roman authors.

Numerous “enlightenments” occurred especially in Britain, France, and Germany. The 1789 French Revolution can be said to have been influenced by enlightenment ideals.
