A common additional symptom for children with ADHD may be impulsivity. Impulsive behavior may cause hasty actions that can be disruptive and potentially harm oneself and others. Early recognition can support families to help with early intervention. Special learning accommodations can enhance learning and help children achieve their potential.

2. GL Chp 3

The concept of “good enough mother” was a concept that resonated with me as a good balance for parenting. A good enough mother does not meet every need of the infant but allows the child to be frustrated and fail sometimes which helps the child develop new skills as they find solutions.

3. JA Chp 8

By four years old as fine motor skills develop which help them to manage a lot of their self care activities like bathing, dressing, feeding, toileting. Between 4 and 5 they develop more ease in these activities.
