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## Son of Man in Enoch and Daniel

Daniel 7 [\(1\)](#) discusses the four beasts that will be rulers of the earth at their time. Bringing destruction that they were intended to bring. The fourth beast was not like the others; it had ten horns and the little horn that destroyed three other horns was the fourth world power; it waged war against God's Holy people. Eventually its kingdom will be destroyed and God's holy people will overtake it.
