

1. We have learned that wind power, water power and, most of all, muscle power were the means by which jobs were done. How do you see these elements conveyed in this film?
 - a. The first example of this is in the Roman gold miner. They had to use muscle power to chip away at rock in order to get to gold. Later, when fire begins to be used for this job, water is used to extinguish the fires.
