## Salvation in the Old Testament

The Ten Commandments are a set of moral and ethical guidelines found in the Bible. They are the foundation for a life of morality and can help us make decisions that are right and demonstrate respect for God. The 10 Commandments appear in the Bible in Exodus 20:1-17 and Deuteronomy 5:6-21. They are a set of laws given to Moses by God on Mount Sinai and are an important part of the Bible. Additionally, Romans 13:8-10 states, “Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law. The commandments, ‘You shall not commit adultery,’ ‘You shall not murder,’ ‘You shall not steal,’ ‘You shall not covet,’ and whatever other command there may be, are summed up in this one command: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ Love does no harm to a neighbor. Therefore love is the fulfillment of the law.” Through these passages, we can see that the New Testament emphasizes the importance of following the Ten Commandments and living a life of love and kindness towards others.

The Old Testament concept of salvation is one of deliverance from danger or destruction. This could include physical salvation from enemies, illness, or any other physical harm, as well

as spiritual salvation from sin and spiritual enemies. The Old Testament emphasizes reliance on God for any type of salvation, whether it be physical or spiritual. The Old Testament also talks about the covenant between God and His people, which is a promise of protection and blessing if they remain faithful to God. This idea of a covenant with God is an important part of the Old Testament concept of salvation.

People in the Old Testament believed that obeying the Ten Commandments would lead to salvation.
