1. **Huguenots** – A French Protestant of the 16-17<sup>th</sup> century, largely Calvinist, and suffered persecution at the hands of the Catholic majority.
2. **Syncretism**-The amalgamation or attempted amalgamation of different religions, cultures, or schools of thought.
3. **Encomienda**- A grant by the Spanish Crown to a colonist in America conferring the right to demand tribute and forced labor from the Indian inhabitants of an area.
