Conservatism: a political philosophy that emphasizes traditional values, institutions, and practices and seeks to limit change and maintain continuity with the past.

Classical Liberalism: a political philosophy that emphasizes individual freedom, the rule of law, private property, and free markets, and seeks to limit the power of the state.

Nationalism: a political ideology that emphasizes the importance of a shared national identity, culture, language, and history, often leading to the desire for an independent state.

Utopian Socialism: a social and economic philosophy that seeks to create a society based on cooperation and communal ownership of the means of production, with the goal of achieving equality and eliminating poverty.

Romanticism: an artistic and literary movement that emphasized emotion, individualism, nature, and the imagination, and rejected the rationalism and scientific thought of the Enlightenment.
