1.Document your initial focused respiratory assessment of Kenneth Bronson.

Patient had an allergic with the antibiotic , ceftriaxone.

Redused lungs sounds at the right of the lungs base, RR17, chest moving equally on both sides.

3. Document Kenneth Bronson’s new allergy information in his patient record.

After the admiration on the antibiotic , patient had areaction to it and it was stop patient felt decrease breath sound on the right side of his lungs and also obstructed

4. Identify and document key nursing diagnoses for Kenneth Bronson.

Ineffective airway clearence related to bronchospasm as evidence by wheezing heard on auscultation.

Patient AAOX4, complained of chest pain, needed antibiotic for pneumonia, ceftriaxone antiobiotic IV administered as per physician order, patient had an allergic reaction to the ABT, wheezing heard on auscultation and ABT stopped due to the reaction ,provider called and medications for allergic reation given as per doctor order. (albuterol, epinephrine, methylprednisolone diphehydrimine, normal saline bolus.) Reassess lungs, heart sounds , vital signs and education given about anaphylaxis reaction to patient and patient left in stable condition.
