3. A war is just when it is the last resort and the idea is that the good gained by fighting must outweigh the evil that is constant and allowed within the conflict. (pg.176)

**TERMS**

1. Folkways – learned behavior that stems from and organizes casual interactions. They involve things like food, eating habits, and fashion style. (pg. 180)
2. Mores – traditions passed on from generation to generation, however, they are related to critical issues and bear a feeling of moral authority by exemplifying a feeling of obligation. (pg. 180)
3. Vested Interest – benefit received from existing arrangements in society or within an institution. It influences values goals and empirical judgments. (pg.183)

**SUMMARY**

The state of moral judgment arises from a combination of beliefs and emotions about morality. Empirical judgment focuses on action and judgment. In empirical knowledge, three categories can be distinguished: (a) knowledge from direct observation, (b) knowledge inferred deductively from observations, and (c) knowledge inferred non-deductively from observations, including knowledge derived by induction and inference to the best explanation.
