<p><b>Short Term Goal:</b></p> <p>Patient has fully foley catheter due to acute urine retention</p> <p><b>Long Term Goal:</b></p> <p>Patient needs urology approval to pee on his own.</p> <p>Alleviate urinary symptoms, restore normal urinary function, and prevent complication.</p>	<p>The patient needs the fully Foley Catheter and he must produce a urine output of 100cc every 4 hours.</p> <p>Monitor Vital signs.</p> <p>Encourage increase fluids if indicated.</p> <p>Monitor input and output</p>	<p>Recommend 3000ml fluid daily to promote flushing and circulation of fluid through kidneys, bladder and ureters.</p> <p>Observe for signs of hypertension and infection. Urinary retention may lead to infection which can be evidenced by fever.</p> <p>Fluid retention put stress on the kidneys and heart and may increase blood pressure and heart rate.</p>	<p>Abdominal pain reduced after fully foley catheter replaced</p>
