When I made the purchase online to buy the box they gave the product to a delivery company like UPS and they shipped the product right to my house.

Uni book: First there is an author or multiple authors who think of something and write it down. When they think they have a version to sell they usually go to a publishing company and ask if they will print and publish the book. When both sides are happy with a final version the

publishing company sends a blueprint to a factory via internet and the factory prints the books. The printed books are shipped to a storage facility from where the book gets shipped to the person who ordered the book.

Samsung phone: The primary design studio is located in Seoul, Korea. This is where the ideas are developed for the phone and where the blueprints are created. When they have a final version they send the blueprint via the internet probably to the central manufacturing hub, which is in Vietnam. Also, all the material necessary for the production of the product is being shipped to the same location. There they put everything together and build the working phones. Then the phones are shipped to a storage or shop. I bought my phone in a shop, so I took it back home myself. (Android)

Bluetooth headphones: First all the materials for the headphones have to be fetched and then shipped to the factory which in this case is located in China. There everything is put together and then shipped to a storage or shop of the brand. When I ordered them a delivery company took them from a storage and shipped them with a truck right to my house.
