

The Gupta Empire

Something I learned from watching the film “India Gupta Empire” is how the Chinese were the masters of ceramic whereas the Indians were the masters of metal, most importantly iron. They used this technique known as “forge welding”, it’s a method of joining two or more pieces of metal together that involves heating them to a malleable state and then hammering them together.
