1. THEORIES IDENTIFIED

(Bowenian) Therapist talked about how society sells a specific image of a mother and mother's care, but not all moms are like this. This perspective provided a sense of normalizing of having mothers who do not fit this "stereotype" or the expectations set by society. Clients received this information well, and they both seemed to appreciate it because it allowed them to share a little more about the lack of support they experienced.
