Wow, this is an interesting topic to think about. After completing 75% of the course content, as the semester comes to an end, I would say the reading exercises from "Readings for Writers" and the grammar exercises from Easy Writer and ChompChomp were the most helpful.

For the reading exercises, "The Writer's Voice" (Castle, 41) was very impactful and caused me to be more careful in writing letters, texts, and reports. I would reread it before sending it, the nine errors to avoid in composing a thesis (96), I have yet to fully grasp it, and "developing good paragraphs" (141–159), that I must continue to work on.
