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This activity was different from the others we had experience so far. I consider this group a realistic scenario we might have in our daily lives and not being aware of our perceptions and responses to it. During this group a lot of other topics came up that can be related to the situation Daniel and his brother are living because they share the space, they live in. As a group we both agreed that Daniel is only focused on his perceptions, his needs and he is not stopping to think what might be causing his brother's behavior. One of the group members stated that he had a coworker who exhibit an unexpected behavior when he responded emergency calls for bloody scenes and accidents. He stated his coworker will make joke about body pieces of death bodies, etc. The classmate stated that one day he asked him about that behavior, and he disclosed that it was his defense mechanism to not let it get to him. In order words his coworker was trying to find a way canalized feeling he had inside. We as a group believe that Daniel should have a conversation with his brother to explore what might be causing his brother to have this behavior continuously. Daniel can also conversate with his brother regarding the house rules and the importance of respecting each other's personal boundaries on the daily basis. Daniel can also use questions that are not punitive, but rather open for his brother to elaborate his perceptions and feelings, which can help him be more self-aware and have a better understanding of his brother's behavior. He can also have a conversation with his brother about his daily routine to help him have a better understanding of the support he might also need from him and the space they live in. Daniel and his brother should also explore areas to reconcile feelings with each other because Daniel seem to have for a long time a perception of his brother that might also affect the way he judges and respond to his behaviors.
