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In his teaching about postmodernism, Dr. Hicks touches on many vital points. One thing that stood out to me is that he points out the logical contradictions made in postmodernism when on one side claiming that “all truth is relative” but on the other side as mentioned by Dr. Hicks “postmodernists will tell you that in some sense their way of looking at things, is the right way of looking at thing” and that “the other narratives need to be set aside” (“Stephen Hicks - Explaining Postmodernism in 2018”).
