The Tibetan Empire had many changes of leadership between 600 ce to 763 ce

- **600 ce Namri Sungsan from the Yarlung Dynasty of the south. He is the descendant of the Tsenpo family who are a long line of Kings.**
- **His son Song Senganpo took the throne at the age of 13 due to the death of the king due to poisoning done by his men**
- **650ce Song Senganpo's son Mong Senganpo inherited the throne at the age of 3yrs old due to the death of his father. But Arunashua (I believe was his fathers right hand man.**
- **Between 660-667 ce Gar Tongen ruled and then he divided the leadership among each of his sons Doosay, Gartran and Trinring.**
- **755- 763 ce Trisonj Detsen led the empire.**
