2 hours / Bridges Fellows Refresh Retreat	I got to share the talk I've been preparing! I really loved being the speaker. I felt like I had something important to share, and the students (and staff) were so engaged. I reflected later that I would do some things differently next time, but the experience was good for me.
.5 hours / Prayer Meeting	The prayer meeting was cut short for a funeral, but the 30 minutes were nice because Lauren introduced a new staff member to their team. It was good to meet her and pray together for the week.
1.5 hours / Mentor Meeting	Lauren and I spent a lot of time debriefing the Refresh retreat. She had a LOT of helpful feedback. Most of it was positive, what went well. She agreed with my ideas of changing some things, and she made her own suggestions. Overall, debriefing with her was deeply encouraging – both because it was one of the biggest speaking engagements I've had, and I needed a pat on the back, and because I was nervous about what she would think after our staff meeting when she was so uncomfortable. But she loved it, and that was exciting. I felt God working deeply in both of our hearts.
3 hours / Staff Meeting	We welcomed the new staffer (Kelly) to the team by going over the staff culture document. I had never seen this document, so it was helpful for me to see how they have designed things intentionally for a certain culture. And at this point, I'm familiar with what they regularly do, so I was able to see how some things on the document do not (or no longer) align with their current practices, and it was helpful for me to see how they discussed those points and made adjustments.
2 hours / Discipleship with Nancy	Today Nancy and I talked about integrity and character. I was able to use the slides I had made for the Worship Night to discuss character development, honesty, and humility. Nancy already understands these concepts in a general sense, but it was good to see how she processed them in light of her new relationship with Jesus.
