39. The three stages of Prenatal Development are germinal, embryonic, and fetal. In the stage of germinal development, at the time of conception, the sperm fertilizes an egg and form a zygote. The zygote develops as a one-cell structure, and when and then, sperm and egg will merge. The embryonic stage begins with the placenta to provide nourishment and oxygen from the mother to the developing embryo. In The fetal stage, after nine weeks, the embryo is a fetus to begin to form a human being.
