Citizens United is a nonprofit corporation. It brought this action in the United States district court for the district of columbia.citizen united has an annual budget of about \$12 million. Most of its funds are from donations by individuals: but, in addition, it accepts a small portion of its funds from for-profit corporations.

 - Justices are appointed by the President, confirmed by the Senate, and insulated from political pressure. The first Amendment provides that congress shall make no law.. Abridging the freedom of speech. Laws enacted to control or suppress speech may operate at different points in the speech process. The law before us is an outright ban, backed by criminal sanctions.
