And all the person depression presents differently from that of a young adult due to an older person's depression can stem from cognitive and move impairment, the loss of pleasure or interest in certain social activities, and neglect of general everyday self-care. Young adults stem from more unresolved mental health psychological problems that may need the prescription of medication to resolve.
