

## Rough draft- Oral History Project

Please pay attention to the following when compiling your project:

1. Let the journalistic questions guide your research, interview and formulation of the final project:

**Who?** (tell us something about the person you are interviewing); **When?** (specifically when did this happen?); **Where?** (where did this happen, if more than one place - include both such as with an immigration story); **What?** (here you tell the story from your person's point of view and what was the person's role in this event?) **How?** (How did the person become involved in this event? How did they feel about it?) and **Why?** (Why were they involved? What led them to this event? )
