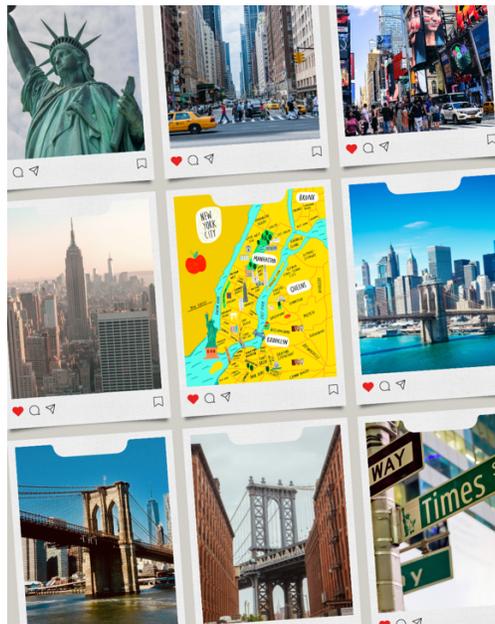

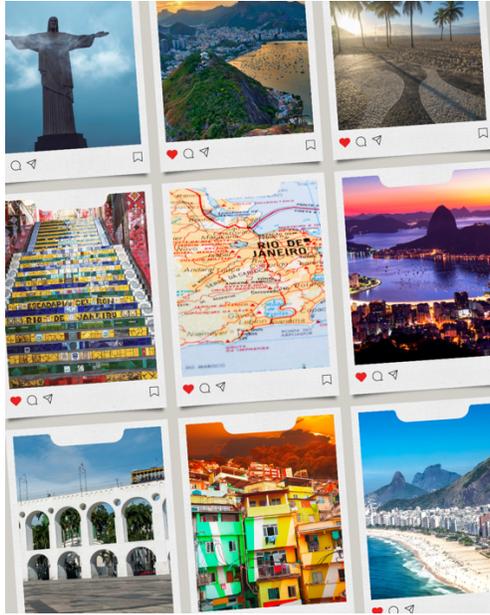
New York City:

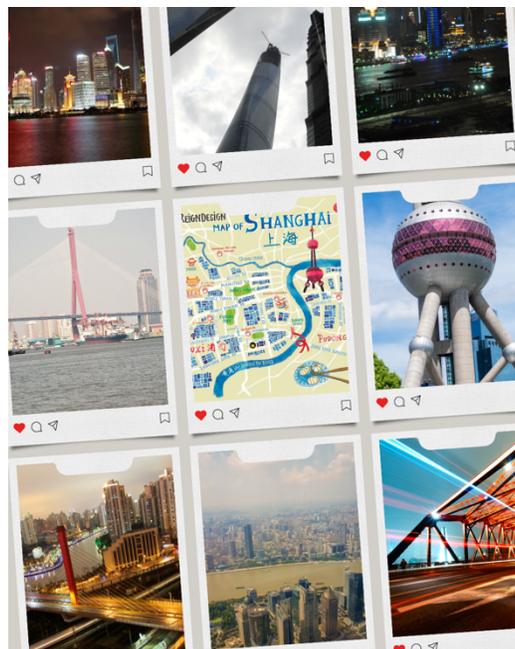
Mumbai:
