| 1.5 hours / Staff Prayer Meeting | I was supposed to lead the staff prayer meeting this morning, but I was late and forgot it was my turn because I had switched with someone three weeks ago when it was supposed to be my turn, so Grace started for me. When I arrived, we read Matthew 21 and meditated on Jesus' last week before his crucifixion. I appreciate being about to worship God through prayer with this group.
