

Unit 1, Lesson 5

- 1.) Worship Helps Connect Gods saving events with the future restoration of all things by connecting you spiritually with music. When we worship in any way either that be internally or externally by dance or by art by singing or by writing or speaking or showing in a reenactment that is all worship unto God it makes us closer to him in every way he gave us life and life more abundantly so that with every inch of our body we may exalt his name and give him praise.
- 2.) So when looking in the book at a dualistic religion we know that in the knowledge based form of of salvation that releases one out of this world in a biblical religion the redeemer saves the creation. So creation isn't even its Gods doing but in a tempered with way.
- 3.) The divine order makes mention that worship should do God's narrative and point to the future when creation, delivered from sin, will be restored to God's original design. - 4.) The purpose of God for all creation is the Genesis account of creation is *doxology* (right praise); it calls us to a posture of praise. Doxology is our response to God's story. It receives God's story as God's way of disclosing his intention for creation.
- 5.) all Israel's covenants and all the worship that proceeds from these covenants call attention to God's intent for the world. Worship continually holds up God's vision of a new heaven and earth and an eternal community of God's people living in fellowship with God, doing God's will on earth, walking in God's ways, and fulfilling the vision of creation.
- 6.) When i was in italy walking into those massive buildings looking at the art work on the walls looking at how people worshiped through art and how they connected with God in some way made me happy that we can explain what God means to us in many ways.
- 7.) *What difference does the interior of the church make to musical acoustics and therefore to the kind of music selected for worship? Internally churches back in the day didn't have microphones or amplifiers so it was so important to make a structure to amplify vibrations making it big and hollow to expand the sound.*

8.) They point to it by building their temple or tabernacle with god in mind and glorifying his name in many ways either that be singing, dancing or art or reading scripture.

9.) Living willingly under the authority of God is the main example of worship that is our purpose and why we were created to use out body to glorify and edify the body of christ.
