To captivate the attention of the readers, outrageous behaviors are encouraged in writing: fictional letters to enemies (Bolker 908). Also to write successfully, the Griseldas of today need to learn what pleases those around them and in so doing there will be no difficulty thinking about the reader (Bolker 907). Putting writing before reading is an effective way to write according to (Elbow 9). When you are writing, write hunches which are referred to as content, write in the mode whether it is imaginative, fiction, poetry or literary (Elbow 12), Work towards clarity (Elbow 13).

These few tips must be avoided because it can cause your writing to be non effective. Ignoring or not acknowledging the reader, ambivalence, nagging questions (Bolker 907). If you don't put reading first passivity is not encouraged (Elbow 9)
