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This week we had stimulation and had different scenarios to assess as groups. During stimulation we had a few scenarios on seizures, sepsis shock and Hypoglycemia. This stimulation was interesting because we had to save different type of patients with different scenarios which helped us practice these situations if it was in real life. One of the areas where I struggled during the simulation was remembering the drugs for each scenario. I think what will help me by remembering the drugs better is by associating each problem with the medication. One of the areas where I was comfortable with was my skills during the scenario and thinking quickly to manage the scenario on time. I was glad I was able to have this stimulation experience because it has helped me gain knowledge and a better understanding on how to approach these cases. These past few weeks have been a long and hard one battling family issues and nursing school. I always look to God for everything and trust in God. I have been struggling in pediatrics class, and I wish I would have more time to study for all my classes and get better grades but sometimes life gets into the way and it's hard to manage everything when you are under stress. One of the bible verses that helped me out the most was Phillipians 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
