Jessica Lee on March 1, 2023, at 5pm in person.

- She requested prayer for ministry transition, and for clarity in regards to the direction of her ministry. She expressed she feels to called to the homeless but does not know how to start. While in prayer, the Holy Spirit highlighted the word “enough,” that she may not feel “good enough” for ministry. Prayed for the Lord to increase her confidence and clarity.
- Response & interview process: She said she feels incompetent to do ministry and often times fears that she will not succeed in ministry. The Lord highlighted Psalms 1:1-3 that says, “That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither -- whatever they do prospers”. Post-prayer: Jessica shared how that is one of her favorite psalms. My post-prayer counseling was encouraging her to start small in the ministry/calling the Holy Spirit is leading her to. Even if it is going around her neighborhood and praying for homeless people.
- How do you know that she walked away feeling loved by the father? She felt at peace and more comfort after praying.

Monom Teekham on March 1, 2023, at 5pm in person

- She requested prayer for her back pain; she expressed that during the class she has to stand or sit on the floor because her shoulder and back pain is too strong.
- Response & interview process: After praying, she said the intensity of the pain was not as strong. We prayed again for complete and full healing of her shoulder/back pain. Post-prayer: After prayer Mo said her shoulder and back pain was completely gone.
- How do you know that she walked away feeling loved by the father? She was no longer experiencing pain and felt more comfortable when sitting down/standing.

Joanna Cuesta on April 26, 2023, at 1PM, by phone

- Prayer request for the women of God to see their value and worth.
Her husband - for Him to walk with God and not stay in the sidelines; and for her daughter's identity, she sees her dressing like a boy and remembers how she was upset when she found out she was having a girl instead of a boy when she got pregnant.
- When she mentioned the women the word "Empower" came to mind three times; When praying for her husband, the Holy Spirit highlighted the story of the prodigal son and that her husband will be clothed with the best robes and crowned as a son of God; and the man at the pool of Bethesda, "do you want to be made well?"; When praying for her daughter, the Lord led me to have her repent and renounce every statement she had made over herself and her daughter during pregnancy.
- Response and interview process: I asked what part she sees herself playing with women, she said "Empowering them." She is planning on doing the Proclaim program. I asked her what she used to say or believe during her pregnancy – she used to wish her daughter was a boy and believed boys were better than girls. Did not want her daughter to end up like her. She repented and renounced every lie spoken during her pregnancy and broke every agreement made with those lies and spoke the truth over her daughter.
- Post – prayer: The word "transformation" in big bold letters kept coming to mind. She also said the Lord reminded that her that He made her a promise once when someone was preaching about the prodigal son and told her "I made you a promise and I plan to keep it." How do you know that she walked away feeling loved by the father? She comforted and reminded of the promises of God for her and her family.

Alan Tufino, on April 30, 2023, at 3PM, in person

- Prayer request for wisdom and discernment with finances; to become more disciplined and a better steward of what he has and wisdom on how to continue earning money.
