This course provides employees with the skills needed to administer medication properly and safely; document medical cares correctly in order to maintain an adequate, legal health record; and understand different categories and types of medications and their side effects. The following were demonstrated by the participant: (1) Oral medication (tablet, capsule, lozenge) - bottle and bubble pack; (2) Oral liquid medication; (3) Eye medication (drop and ointment); (4) Ear drop medication; (5) Topical and transdermal medication; (6) Metered dose inhaler. This course is taught by STAR Services RNs. Participants complete a written test and demonstration of medication administration. This training is not a certification of the participant's competency by STAR Services. Assurance of the participant's skills and competencies is the responsibility of the employing company. Some companies may require a participant to demonstrate competency of the medication demonstration skills on/offsite following this course. This course meets 245D requirements for medication administration training.
