Staff will tell Annie that it is "time to make your tea". 2. Staff will help Annie make her tea by proving her with verbal and point prompts as needed. 3. If Annie assists in making her tea staff will record a (Y) and will reinforce Annie with verbal praise and allowing her to drink her tea. 4. If Annie does not assist in making her tea staff will record a (N) a will make Annie's tea while she observes. Annie will still be able to drink her tea.
