What are you looking forward to this year? Due to Shereen's limited verbal abilities, guardian replied. Shereen will hopefully find a place she feels comfortable living, and is supported by those around her.

Do you like where you live? Due to Shereen's limited verbal abilities, guardian replied. Where Shereen lives is great for her, but it is not long term.

Do you want to move? Yes.

Do you want to live in a less restrictive setting? Yes.

Do you feel a part of the community around you? Due to COVID, and recent move, no.

What makes you feel this way? COVID and recent move.

She loves to go shopping, likes wearing cool clothes and listening to her music.

Action Steps for Goals:

What will the person do? Shereen will work with her formal and informal supports to build and maintain her skills to reach her goals.

What will the case manager do? Her Case Manager will work with her formal and informal supports to build and maintain her skills to reach her goals while ensuring that her health and safety needs are being met. Her Case Manager will work together to explore other housing options that will be able to increase her access to the community to do the things she enjoys. Her Case Manager will work with her Guardian to find a permanent placement for Shereen that meets her needs. CM will monitor, coordinate and assist in resolving conflict with providers as needed.

What will others do? Her Guardian, Diane Justin, will work with her formal and informal supports to build and maintain her skills to reach her goals while ensuring that her health and safety needs are being met. She will work with her Case Manager to explore other housing options that meet her needs. She will continue to be her rep payee. She will purchase a new ipad for Shereen.

What will the provider do? Her providers TBD (residential) and Phoenix alternatives (DTH) will work with her formal and informal supports to build and maintain her skills to reach her goals while ensuring that her health and safety needs are being met. Both providers will teach Shereen more American Sign Language to improve her communication skills. Her day program will give her opportunities to do the shredding job.

RISKS

How will Health and Safety Issues be Addressed?

Shereen requires 24 hour asleep overnight staff supervision. Her current temporary transitional crisis bed provides this level of care for her. She needs to find a permanent residential placement in the community that meets her needs. She needs a Guardian, rep payee and staff to ensure that her basic needs are being met. Her Guardian and support services will work together to ensure that her basic needs are being met. She has an IDD Case Manager who will work with her team to coordinate her services and ensure that her providers are meeting her needs. Her team will work together to protect her as a vulnerable adult.

The following table documents and acknowledges any risks that exist based on identified remaining needs above.
