<p>Name: Nicholas Kessler Outcome #: 1 Date of development: 1.7.2021 Projected start date for implementation: 1.18.2021 Date by which progress towards accomplishing the outcome will be reviewed and evaluated: July 2021</p>
<p>Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement: Daily, Nicholas will use ASL to sign yes/no to indicate his activity preference in 70% of all trials over the next year.</p>
<p>Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome:</p> <p>Staff will inform Nick of his options for an activity. Staff will then show Nick the sign for “yes” and the sign for “no.” Staff will present the first option and will encourage Nick to make the choice independently.</p> <p>If Nick attempts to make the sign, he will be praised, and the outcome will be documented as achieved (Y). If Nick signs “no” that he does not want to participate in the activity, staff will go on to the next option and repeat the steps.</p> <p>If Nick does not make a sign, staff will give him space and ask again later. If Nick still does not make a choice after being asked again, the outcome will be documented as not achieved (N).</p>
<p>Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments: Nick works well with little distractions and in a quiet area.</p>
<p>Equipment and/or materials required: There is no equipment or materials needed for this outcome.</p>
<p>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person’s communication mode: Nicholas understands verbal communication but communicates using facial expressions, vocalizations, and gestures. He may also push away items when he is disinterested in them.</p>
<p>Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person’s learning style: Nicholas learns through repetition, routine, and verbal and physical cues. This outcome will be completed daily to establish routine and he will be provided both physical and verbal cues.</p>
<p>Data collection method: Documentation will be recorded and charted daily. Charting will include a Y or N indicating success.</p>
<p>Names of staff or positions responsible for implementing the supports and methods: Program Supervisor (PS), Lead Direct Support Professional (LDSP) and Direct Support Professionals (DSP)</p>
