When Tiffany arrives in the morning, staff will prompt her to go to her seat and model taking off her backpack. 2. Staff will then verbally prompt Tiffany by telling her "It's time to put Tiffy's things in Tiffy's spot" 3. Staff will assist Tiffany with whatever she may need help with, such as taking off her backpack. 4. If Tiffany does not want to put away her backpack, staff will continue to encourage her to put her things away every half hour in order to reinforce that she should settle in for the day.
