Outcome statement with measurable and observable criteria for outcome achievement:	
Three times a day, Madrid will use his iPad to request a preferred item, at 80% over a 6-month period.	
Methods or actions that will be used to support the person and to accomplish the outcome:	
This outcome will be ran <b>daily</b> with an intended success rate of 80%, over the next 6 months.	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. If Madrid appears to want an item (sensory toy, yogurt, spoon etc.) staff will present him with his iPad and will say "what do you want?"</li> <li>2. Staff can provide point and verbal prompts to request the item on his iPad</li> <li>3. If Madrid uses his iPad to request the item, staff will record a Y and will verbally praise Madrid</li> <li>4. If Madrid does not use his iPad to request the item, staff will record a N, will model the correct response and will try again when another opportunity arises.</li> </ol>	
Changes or modifications necessary to the physical and social environments: N/A	
Equipment and/or materials required: preferred items, iPad	
Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's communication mode: Madrid is mostly non-verbal but can say a few words. Madrid primarily communicates with his iPad, vocalizations and facial expressions.	
Techniques that are used that are consistent with the person's learning style: Madrid learns best through modeling and repetition.	
Data collection method: Documentation will be recorded and charted daily. Charting will include a Y or N indicating success.
