When Kaleena is upset, staff will say "Let's use your calm down kit" (or similar language). 2. If Kaleena uses an item in her "calm down kit" staff will record a "Y" and will verbally praise Kaleena. 3. If Kaleena does not use an item in her "calm down kit", staff will record a "N" and will try again at the next opportunity.
